Recycling Materials Accepted at our Drop Off Facility:

- Newspapers: Dry, No Strings or Plastic Bags
- **❖** Magazines & Catalogs: Dry, No Strings or Plastic Bags
- Clear, Brown & Green Glass: Rinsed and Clean *Note: No plate glass, mirrors, auto or drinking glasses.
- Tin Cans and Bi-metal Lids (Example: from a pickle jar, etc.): Rinsed
 Clean
- #1 and #2 plastic only (Including lids on bottles or jugs): Rinsed, Clean and <u>Flattened!</u> Remove from plastic bags.*Note: No motor oil or anti-freeze containers!!
- **❖** Aluminum Cans (<u>Cans Only!!!! Remove cans from plastic bags. No aluminum Foil or Foil Pans.)</u>
- Card Board (Please break down all card board boxes flat.)
- Chip Board (Cereal boxes, Tissue Boxes, etc.): <u>Break down to flat</u>. Nothing with a wax coating.
- Pizza Boxes (<u>Please break down to flat and no grease or food residue</u>)
- Office paper, Shredded or not, Can be bagged but not necessary.
- Envelopes, with or without plastic window
- Junk mail & Greeting Cards
- Notebook paper (One subject, etc.)
- Paperback and Hard Cover Books

All card board, chip board, pizza boxes, office paper, envelopes, junk mail, paperback & hard cover books, greeting cards & notebook paper are to be placed in the same container labeled card board & office paper.
