Special Meeting
April 14, 2016

A Special Meeting of the Lewis Township Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Willard Murray at 6:00 P.M. at the Lewis Township building. Those present were Supervisors Willard Murray and Jay Douglas Bomberger and Duane M. Blakeney, Solicitor Benjamin Landon, Secretary/Treasurer Lucinda R. Bomberger and 4 guests.

Public Comment on Agenda Items

Mark Burrows, Delaware Township Assistant Secretary, attended the meeting to speak to the Supervisors regarding Lewis Township and Northern Neighbors. Mark presented a proposal of goals, objectives, financial responsibility, other interests and services in regards to the Lewis Township Wastewater System connecting to Milton Regional Sewer Authority. The purpose of this proposal was to ask if the Supervisors would be interested in considering this alternative if the Warrior Run School District would agree to pay for all costs involved including Bill and Mark's time to consult on this project. There was brief discussion on the benefits and selling points to regionalizing.

A motion was made by Willard Murray, seconded by Duane M. Blakeney and passed to authorize William Michael and Mark Burrows to proceed in pursuing the possibility of connecting to Northern Neighbors, conducting further investigation and submitting a concrete proposal. Lewis Township will decide the proper time to involve the Warrior Run School District with this proposal. It was the desire of Supervisor Willard Murray that involvement with the school district wait until after Dr. John Kurelja's departure of his position as Superintendent.

New Business

A motion was made by Willard Murray, seconded by Duane M. Blakeney and passed to authorize Benjamin E. Landon, Solicitor, to seek services of an engineer for review of a Stormwater and Land Development Plan submitted by Randall Webster on behalf of Moses Yoder.
