

Lewis Township Supervisors Special Meeting
January 16, 2019

A special meeting of the Lewis Township Supervisors was called to order by Chairman Willard Murray at 8:03 A.M. at the Lewis Township building. Those also present were Supervisors Duane M. Blakeney and Ricky Dyer, Solicitor Jonathan Dewald and Secretary/Treasurer Lucinda R. Bomberger.

Old Business

A motion was made by Willard Murray, seconded by Duane M. Blakeney and passed to appoint Lucinda R. Bomberger as delegate to the Northumberland County Tax Collection Committee.

New Business

A motion was made by Ricky Dyer, seconded by Willard Murray and passed to adopt Ordinance No. 2019-1, an Ordinance amending Ordinance 2018-9 by providing for the appointment of a sinking fund depository for the note authorizes by Ordinance 2018-9 and providing for the authorized signatories and authorizing execution, sale or delivery thereof.

A motion was made by Willard Murray, seconded by Ricky Dyer and passed to authorize the opening of the Lewis Township Sewer Project Sinking Fund at the Muncy Bank & Trust Company.

A letter from Red Barn Consulting on behalf of Jeremy Erb in regards to a Land Development Plan for Poultry Operation was submitted requesting a deferral of review to Turbot Township due to construction and operations to be solely in Turbot Township and would have no adverse effect on Lewis Township. A motion was made by Willard Murray, seconded by Duane M. Blakeney and passed to approve the review deferral contingent upon Turbot Township approving the plan as submitted without changes. The Supervisors would like to request notification of any changes made to the Land Development Plan.

A motion was made by Willard Murray, seconded by Ricky Dyer and passed to adjourn the meeting at 8:26 A.M.
